



FAQ

What are “light infantry days”?

These are typically the early days of the season, when the road in to the main parking area is not dry enough for vehicular traffic.

PLEASE take note:

- Players must have all guns in gun bags, boxes or blankets while on Whitney Road (OPP officer lives next door folks!) **Anyone seen walking down Whitney road with guns not in bags/concealed will not be allowed access!**
- Travel light, it's only a 250m walk to the clubhouse and storage/prep building (space for 40 players and gear).
- We will run an equipment shuttle with the ATV from 0900 to 0930 hrs. Games start 10am, as usual.

What time do games start and end?

We usually get started around 10am and play until 1pm. Take 45 minutes for lunch and then we go until approx 4:30.

Please be here and ready to play for 10am!

What time should my parents/ride be here to pick me up?

If you are being dropped off, your ride/parent/guardian etc must be back here by 4 pm at the latest! Even if we are still playing until 4:30. Failure to show up for player pick up at 4pm will result in that player or players losing their drop-off privileges.

How many people usually show up for walk on days and or events?

Usually we see anywhere from 10 to 50 players on any given walk-on day. We have no control over player turnout or the weather. You guys do! Ask any veteran, we have as much or more fun with a dozen players as we do with 100.

Events average 75 to 125 players and are always walk-on friendly.

I am a new player, will I be ok?

YES! RDA has a great reputation for welcoming new players. Proof of such can be read at length on Facebook page reviews. Just come out and have fun.

Can I just “show up”?

Yes, all our games and events are walk-on friendly. Please get here by 9:30 at the latest so you don't miss out on any of the action.

Do you sell any gear/misc. items?

We sell BBs, Gatorade and good safe fun. We no longer run a retail outfitter depot on the field. And no, we don't have HPA.

How many batteries should I bring?

You should have at least two fully charged batteries for a day of play. We provide power for you to charge our batteries and there are two work stations for repairs on site. One in the assembly area and the second in the muster area, right in the center of the battlefield.

Do you have any maps of the field?

Yes, ask at the registration desk.

Can I bring my own BBs?

Yes, and we sell bbs if you forget to bring extras! The only exception is if you are renting. You must use our bbs in the rental guns to avoid damage.

What kind of rentals do you have?

We have a variety of guns from G&G and Valken, M4- style, typically. See FEE page for more details.

Can I reserve a rental?

Rentals are first come first served. For larger group rentals, reservation arrangements can be made by contacting us directly, deposit required.

Can I use smoke grenades or other devices?

Commercial grade smoke devices are allowed. Homemade devices, grenades, stick bombs, toilet paper bombs, etc are all strictly forbidden. Thunder Bs and any other “sound devices” are also forbidden.

Can I come and just shoot on the range all day?

No. The range is closed during gameplay unless you are testing your gun after repairs.

Do you play in the rain?

OF COURSE! Some of our most epic games have been played in the rain or snow. Just dress accordingly and you will be fine.

Do you sell or supply bug juice/insect repellent?

NO! Its Canada folks and this an outdoor field so bring what you need to stay comfortable.

Do you sell food?

No, you should bring food. We supply water for free and sell Gatorade.

What should I wear?

Dress comfortably with proper footwear and jeans or fatigues. Dress in layers for cooler weather so you can take them off as you warm up, and you will warm up quick once you start to play!

Please try not to wear any hats, t-shirts or other pieces of clothing that are RED. This colour is used by players to signify being “dead”(kill rags).

Do I need a “kill rag”?

This is a good item to have. It’s not mandatory but highly recommended. You can make your own or purchase them online. We use red.

Will I get to play with my team and or buddies all day?

We always strive to put people with their buddies as much as possible. Teams are re-configured during walk on days due to the nature of the game being played, ie some games are a larger attacking force vs a smaller defending force.
